As part of the nation-building EnergyConnect project, we have completed construction of the Cobb Highway accommodation camp and construction laydown located approximately 40km south of Hay. The camp is now operational and will provide accommodation for our project

workforce while we continue transmission line construction activities between Balranald and Bundure for the duration of the project.

Operational works at the camp complex will occur **Monday to Sunday, 6am to 7pm** (including public holidays).
