

Elecnor Australia has been contracted by Transgrid to deliver part of EnergyConnect with the construction of 700km of new power lines from the SA border to the regional energy hub of Wagga Wagga. The project will connect the electrical grids of New South Wales, South Australia, and Victoria, improving reliability of our nation's energy supply.

Maintenance activities

The EnergyConnect project team is undertaking scheduled maintenance on the 220kV line from Buronga Substation, NSW, to Red Cliffs Substation in Victoria.

As part of this work, Elecnor will be replacing the existing overhead heavy earth wire (OHEW) between **Friday 10 April** and **Saturday 18 April 2026**.

Work outside of approved construction hours

The approved hours of work are:

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday
- 8am to 1pm Saturdays

Work outside these standard construction hours are scheduled for this activity. This is to ensure these activities are carried out safely and to minimise disruption to the community. Work will take place, weather permitting, Monday to Sunday 7am to 7pm including Public Holidays.

How could this affect you?

Residents of Wentworth Shire Council and Mildura Rural City Council

- Motorists should be aware of additional project vehicles entering and exiting the Sturt Highway and Arumpo Road and drive to the conditions as our crews carry out the work required on the transmission line.
- During construction activity there may be delays of up to 15 minutes for motorists due to traffic control.

Types of plant and equipment being used

- The type of plant and equipment you can expect to see Includes elevated work platforms (up to 70 metres in height), trucks moving equipment between sites and light vehicles.

How we're managing impacts

Traffic management

There will be traffic control in place on the Sturt Highway and Arumpo Road to ensure your safety. Please keep to the sign posted speed limits and allow for any delays to your travelling plans during this time.

Noise and vibration


We will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- Minimising the number of machines/vehicles to be used
- Ensuring all machinery and vehicles are maintained and serviced
- Turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- Fitting equipment with devices to minimise noise
- Using water carts, stabilising stockpiles and reducing speed on unsealed roads to suppress dust
- Monitoring dust, noise and vibration to manage any potential impacts and change our work if required.
